## WP1 and 2 Teams Review Policies and Community Insights on Wildfire Risk

The work package (WP) 1 and 2 teams reviewed existing state-level policies, plans, and practices for risk reduction. They identified a formal network of major actors and their relationships with other actors based on these formal policies and plans. A semantic network analysis using California laws and policies reveals the key federal and state-level organizations with legal authority for wildfire risk reduction interacting with other federal, state, county, and municipal governments to manage risk of hazardous events.


In the depicted network diagram, two prominent state entities, the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) and California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CalFire) are the key organizations that interact with one another in managing wildfire hazards. Each of these organizations also has a sub-network of federal, state, and county organizations with which they communicate and exchange information and resources to support risk reduction and response operations. The sub-networks are connected through the two lead agencies. However, some organizations with responsibilities for managing key support programs are not connected with either CalOES or CalFire, forming isolated networks with fewer connections and focused on distinct activities rather than the shared goal of hazard risk reduction. These organizations manage health and housing resources that are likely to be central to risk reduction activities *before*, or managing recovery *after*, a wildfire event. Their isolation from the primary networks may limit their access to resources and their capacity to share and update information before, during, and after hazardous events.

The WP 1 and 2 teams collaborated with the WP 5 team to develop interview protocols for leaders of three types of community organizations: informal organizations involving largely volunteer efforts at wildfire risk reduction; formal organizations with formal responsibilities for wildfire risk reduction and mitigation; and organizations with responsibilities for long-term planning for wildfire mitigation.

The WP 1 and 2 teams conducted 30 interviews of leaders of formal and informal community organizations regarding their experience with wildfire hazards in years of intensive wildfire activity, 2017-2022, and how that experience influenced practice in communications, coordination, and information flows for wildfire risk and mitigation activities. The sample of community organizations included 18 nonprofit organizations, 8 public organizations, and 4 private organizations. The WP1 and 2 teams have also conducted 10 interviews, so far, with leaders of formal community organizations with legal responsibility for wildfire risk reduction and long-term mitigation.

The WP1 and 2 teams plan to share the findings of interviews with community partners and continue to interview participants as they analyze the networks of community organizations and legal authorities based on interviews.
